- 9. What role did churches or other religious institutions play in your life in RP?
- 10. What was your first job in Rohnert Park or in the area?
- 11. How did Rohnert Park change over the first decade or two that you lived here?
- 12. What do you think are some of the major milestones in the city's history during your lifetime? Could you talk about your perspective on these events?
- 13. What's the relationship between Cotati and Rohnert Park? Change over time?
