Scope and Contents

The State Law Enforcement Citizen Advisory Commission works to improve policing practices within law enforcement agencies under the Governor's jurisdiction. The Commission is comprised of Pennsylvania citizens focused on promoting transparency, fairness, and accountability among the Commonwealth's state law enforcement agencies by examining events and conducting reviews of policies, practices, and procedures.

The publications of the State Law Enforcement Citizen Advisory Commission contain annual reports and final incident reports. Selected topics from these publications include yearly agency happenings and case files on uses of force.

Biographical / Historical

The State Law Enforcement Citizen Advisory Commission was created by Governor Wolf through executive order 2020-04, to take effect on April 30, 2021. The Executive Order requires the establishment of committees to review investigations of police-involved shootings resulting in injury or death of civilians, other uses of force, and allegations of bias-based policing. It also allows for the establishment of subcommittees to effectively implement its authority and responsibilities. The Rules Subcommittee has been established for this purpose.
