Scope and Contents

The Office of the Budget develops, coordinates, and oversees the execution of a balanced financial plan for the Commonwealth that reflects the policies and priorities of the Governor, promotes the efficient allocation and use of resources, and ensures that all funds received and disbursed for Commonwealth programs are accounted for in accordance with current laws, regulations, and policies. The Secretary and his staff carry out special analyses on all aspects of fiscal policy for the Governor and provide the other senior officials of the Commonwealth with the information they need to evaluate the impact of current and possible new policies and programs on the financial operations of the Commonwealth. As the head of the Office of the Budget, the Secretary has overall responsibility for preparation of the Governor's budget and its implementation after legislative enactment. The Secretary is also responsible for maintaining the Commonwealth's accounting, payroll, debt issuance, and financial reporting systems and programs. The heads of the Governor's Budget Office, the Office of Comptroller Operations, the Office of Administrative Services, and the Executive Director of Pennvest report directly to the Secretary of the Budget.

The publications of the Office of the Budget contain newsletters, budget reports, annual reports, and other reports. Selected topics from these publications include liquor privatization, the state budget allocations, the Pennsylvania Horsemen's Association, etc. The bulk of the current material is dated from 1969 to present.

Biographical / Historical

The Office of the Budget is authorized and enacted by the Administrative Code of 1929, established within the Governor's Office.
