Scope and Contents

The Pennsylvania Securities Commission consisted of three commissioners appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate. The Commission was responsible for administering the Pennsylvania Securities Act of 1972; the Act of May 15, 1933; and the Takeover Disclosure Law of Pennsylvania (Act No. 19 of Mar. 3, 1976). The primary purpose of the regulatory responsibilities and objectives was to protect the public from fraudulent practices in connection with the offer, sale, and purchase of securities in Pennsylvania while, at the same time, encouraging the financing of legitimate business and industry in the Commonwealth.

The publications of the Pennsylvania Securities Commission contain compendiums. Selected topics from these publications include commission orders and required act reporting. The bulk of the current material is dated from 2011.

Biographical / Historical

Acts 164 and 165 of April 13, 1927 created the Securities Commission within the Department of Banking and conferred upon it the Department's responsibilities pursuant to the Securities Act of June 14, 1923. The Commission was created in response to significant changes to the Security Law. Acts 171 and 172 of 1975 made the Commission independent and separate from the Banking Department. The Department of Banking and Securities Commission were combined to create the Department of Banking and Securities effective October 1, 2012.
