The Legislative Audit Advisory Commission is a bipartisan, bicameral legislative service agency, or joint committee, of the Pennsylvania General Assembly. The powers and duties of the commission include: examine the standards of audits performed under the provisions of section 10 of Article VIII, of the Constitution of Pennsylvania, and recommend measures for the improvement of pre-auditing and post-auditing of the financial affairs of the Commonwealth; report annually recommendations and suggested legislation, if any, for the improvement of auditing in the Commonwealth, and particularly as it pertains to the Legislature.

The publications of the Legislative Audit Advisory Commission contain audit reports and financial statement communications. Selected topics from these publications include General Assembly finances. The bulk of the current material is dated from 2007 to present.

Biographical / Historical

The Legislative Audit Advisory Commission was created by Act 151 of 1970 (71 P.S. § 1189.2).
